ZINFANDEL

The origins of Zinfandel is perhaps thought to have began in Austria, from there migrating to Puglia in Southern Italy and then to California where it has found it's home.

Zinfandel is quintessentially Californian with bold, brazen flavors of raspberry jam, dried plums, fresh cracked pepper and a dusting of exotic spice.

Zinfandel doesn't try to be as elegant or serious as other big red's, but it is hedonistic and satisfying.
